

BOARD OF ELECTIONS AND REGISTRATION BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:00PM

Approval of Agenda

Mrs. Good requested a motion to approve the agenda. Mr. Evans made the motion and Mr. Proctor seconded. The agenda was approved unopposed.

Office Operations Report

Mrs. Green announced that staff from the Douglas County Board of Elections and Registration office attended the annual Georgia Association of Voter Registration and Election Officials (GAVREO) Conference last week from Sunday, August 10 until Wednesday, August 13 in Savannah, Georgia. She explained that this conference affords the opportunity to meet with other election professionals and exchange ideas and procedures as well as receive credentials to maintain certification as election officials.

Mr. Unvala informed the board that the municipal qualifying period ended yesterday on August 20th noting that both the cities of Villa Rica and Douglasville have had candidates qualify in each contest that will appear on November's ballot. He noted that this

information is published on the county website under “Candidate Information” and it can also be found on the Secretary of State’s website.

Mrs. Green explained that after the previous list maintenance activities conducted over the past few weeks, 6,672 Douglas County registrations have been moved to Cancelled Status. She noted that any individual who has been cancelled in this process is free to register to vote again provided they meet the normal requirements.

Mr. Fairley announced that he has been coordinating with the county’s Communication Department to produce a series of PSA regarding the recent list maintenance activities.

Mrs. Green announced that the office has processed its backlog of voter registrations, reminding the board that these voter registration processes are paused during active elections. She explained that registrations will continue to be processed as they’re received until the October 6 registration deadline for the November election.
