Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 4:30PM.

Approval of Agenda

Mrs. Good requested a motion to approve the agenda. Mr. Hurry made the motion and Mr. Proctor seconded. The agenda was approved unopposed.

Approval of Minutes of the 7 November 2025 Regularly Scheduled Board Meeting & Certification Meeting

Mrs. Good requested a motion to approve the minutes from the previous Regularly Scheduled Board Meeting. Mr. Evans made the motion and Mr. Proctor seconded. The minutes were approved unopposed.

Certification of Returns of the 2 December 2025 Municipal Runoff Elections

Mr. Unvala explained that the Election Summary Report is the same as what was presented during the Precertification Meeting with the only change being the title of “Unofficial and Incomplete” to “Official and Complete.” He noted that by combining Douglas County’s figures with Carroll County’s for Villa Rica’s totals, Tyler Barr won the runoff for Ward 4 and Dominique Conteh won the runoff for Ward 5. He explained that between the two contests the turnout was over 12%, which was higher than previous municipal runoffs in recent years.

Mrs. Good requested a motion to certify the returns of the 2 December 2025 Municipal Runoff Election. Mr. Proctor made the motion and Mr. Hurry seconded the motion. The returns were certified unopposed.

Office Operations Report

Mrs. Green informed the board that the Douglas County Elections Office would resume processing Voter Registration Applications on Monday, 8 December. She explained that all registrations received by the office since the registration deadline for the November Election have been held and maintained by the office. She explained that there are several thousand to be processed.

Director Kidd extended his gratitude to all poll workers and staff for another successful election noting the difficulties holding a runoff with such short turnaround time.

Mrs. Good echoed those sentiments on behalf of the Board, adding that the Early Voting period occurred during the Thanksgiving holiday.
