**ORDER CLOSING COURTHOUSE AND  
DECLARATION OF JUDICIAL EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that a judicial emergency exists in this county such that there is either a state of emergency as declared by the Governor, a weather emergency, or a state of emergency as declared by the Douglas County Commissioners;

**WHEREAS**, the emergency substantially endangers or infringes upon the normal functioning of the judicial system, the ability of persons to avail themselves of the judicial system, or the ability of litigants or others to have access to the courts or meet scheduled or time deadlines imposed by the court order or rule, statute of administrative rule or regulation;

**IT IS ORDERED** that, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-61, the Courts of **DOUGLAS** County shall be closed **Monday, January 26, 2026**.

Further notice will be provided should conditions warrant an extension of this closure. Updates will be posted at [www.douglascountyga.gov](http://www.douglascountyga.gov) and shared on social media.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-62, all court deadlines, time schedules or filing requirements are hereby suspended, tolled, or extended for the duration of the judicial emergency as noted above; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, to satisfy the continuity of operations of the court system, and to ensure that the Douglas County community has access to justice during this weather emergency and closure, individuals may contact the courts as follows:

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Sheriff or his/her designee shall post a copy of this notice on the courthouse doors; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Clerk of the Superior Court, or his/her designee, shall immediately notify the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court and the Clerks of the Court of Appeals and Supreme Court by sending them a copy of this notice; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the County Manager, or his/her designee, shall post a copy of this notice and any subsequent modification or extension in accordance with O.C.G.A § 38-3-63 by posting it on the county website or other appropriate public address system.
