STANDING ORDER FOR DOMESTIC RELATIONS CASES UNDER GA.CODE § 19-1-1


All Parties in each Divorce or any Domestic Relations case in the Superior Court of the Douglas Judicial Circuit are subject to this Order from the date and time of filing suit.

In each case, to-wit,

1. Each Party is hereby enjoined and restrained from causing or permitting the minor children of the parties to be removed from the jurisdiction of this Court.
2. Each Party is hereby enjoined and restrained from doing, or attempting to do, or threatening to do, any act of injuring, maltreating, vilifying, molesting or harassing the adverse party or any of the children of the parties.
3. Each Party is hereby enjoined and restrained from selling, encumbering contracting to sell, or otherwise disposing of or removing any of the property belonging to the parties from the jurisdiction of the Court except in the ordinary course of business.
4. The custody and control of any minor children of the parties shall vest immediately in the parent having physical custody of said children on the tenth day prior to filing of this action unless otherwise order by the Court.
5. This Order shall survive any further orders in this case until a Final Order.
6. This Order shall be binding upon the parties in the above styled action filed in the Superior Court of the Douglas Judicial Circuit, their agents, and all other persons acting in concert with said parties.
7. In all cases that require the determination of support for minor children, the parties shall comply with Ga.Code § 19-6-15 by filing properly completed child support worksheets, applicable domestic relations affidavits, and where required, income deduction orders.
8. In all cases that require the determination of custody of minor children, the parties shall comply with Ga.Code §19-9-1 by filing a parenting plan that complies with the provisions of state law.


It is ordered that a copy of this Order be entered in each Domestic Relations Case (including family violence cases) in which injunctive relief is sought in the Douglas Judicial Circuit by the Clerk of said Court immediately upon the filing of each domestic relations complaint, and that a copy hereof be attached to each complaint for service upon every defendant in said case.

It is so ordered this March 18, 2025.




