Mission

To operate, maintain, expand, and develop a safe efficient balanced transportation system that supports existing and future travel demand by offering viable multiple mode choice alternatives that meet quality of life expectations for all Douglas County citizens.

Departmental Functions

- **Maintain and preserve a safe and efficient roadway infrastructure through pavement resurfacing and repair, right of way and vegetation management, and bridge and guardrail preservation**
- **Manage planning & programming activities, transportation initiatives, and capital improvement programs that support the Douglas County Department of Transportation mission**
- **Install, maintain, and improve transportation operations through management of traffic control devices; signage, pavement markings, and traffic signal systems**
- **Study and continuously optimize and document measures of effectiveness related to traffic operations performance**
- **Manage the preconstruction, design, and construction engineering and inspection services of all Douglas County Department of Transportation administered projects**

2010 Goals

- 1. Improve safety and reduce the number of crashes on the county's roadway system by enhancing the night time and wet weather visibility of the roadway system with reflective all weather pavement markings, implementation of street lighting, and continuing the county wide paved shoulder and curve improvement plan.**
- 2. Maximize efficiency of the existing transportation system by adding capacity to the roadway and intersections, optimizing signal timing, improving lane configurations, and upgrading signals at county intersections.**
- 3. Improve the bridge maintenance program to preserve bridge assets and reduce adverse effects on the environment by eliminating lead paint from the bridges and reducing soil erosion under & around bridge structures.**
