

### **NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE**

The **Douglas County Board of Commissioners** has tentatively adopted a 2021 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by **12.41** percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings regarding this tax increase on Tuesday, **August 24, 2021 at 10 a.m. to be held virtually via Zoom Call-in # 888-788-0099, ID 970 9517 5022** and at **6:00 p.m. to be held virtually via Zoom Call-in# 888-788-0099, ID 941 8559 1550**. Citizens may register to speak at the public hearings with the County Clerk at (lwatson@co.douglas.ga.us) or by calling (770-920-7416) by noon on Monday, August 23, 2021.

Time and place of an additional public hearing on this tax increase will be held Tuesday, **August 31, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. to be held via Zoom Call in # 888-788-0099, ID 970 2452 1344**.

This tentative tax increase will result in the millage rate increase at 13.563 mills, an increase of **1 mills**. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than **12.089 mills**. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of **\$200,000** is approximately **\$118** and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of **\$225,000** is approximately **\$133**.
