

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The **Douglas County Board of Commissioners** has tentatively adopted a 2022 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 5.33 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited and may speak at the public hearing on Tuesday, **August 16, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** regarding this tax increase to be held in Citizens Hall at the Douglas County Courthouse at 8700 Hospital Drive, Douglasville, GA 30134.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase will be held Thursday, **August 25, 2022, at 10:00 a.m.** to be held in Citizens Hall at the Douglas County Courthouse at 8700 Hospital Drive, Douglasville, GA 30134.

This tentative tax increase will result in the millage rate remaining the same at **12.563** mills, an increase of **.636 mills**. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than **11.927 mills**. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of **\$200,000** is approximately **\$47.06** and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of **\$225,000** is approximately **\$57.24**.
